

ScanShark Data Upload/Processing Operations

This is based upon a computer that already has the ScanShark drivers installed and all the ScanShark and associated software installed as well.

1. After counting the inventory, connect the ScanShark to the PC with the USB cable.
2. On the ScanShark, go to the Main Menu, press 5, press 1
3. On the PC, double-click the ScanShark Communications Portal icon on your PC' desktop. You should see the serial number and the number of data entries appear on the PC.
4. From the Portals screen, under the portion for "Data", click Browse.
5. Name the file that you will create in the next step. Hint: Give the file a name that is logical and you will be able to know what inventory it is for and which date. Example: "Joe's Market September 15 2006", Click Open.
6. Click "Upload to PC", you will see the counter count-off your data record as it uploads. When done, click the "Close" button. Turn OFF your ScanShark.
7. If you have more ScanShark' to upload, repeat steps 1 and 2. On the PC, click "View ScanShark Info. You'll see the serial number of the second machine appear along with the number of data entries, etc. Click "Upload to PC". Click OK to proceed with the upload. When done, click the "Close" button and turn OFF your ScanShark.
8. Close the ScanShark Communications Portal by clicking the "Exit" button.
9. Open the ScanShark Data Processing application by clicking the icon on your PC' desktop. After it opens, click the "Data" button. You will go to the Captured Data screen.
10. Click "Receive Uploaded Data", Click "YES" to confirm that any data already showing will be deleted.
11. Select the file that you created in step 5. Click Open. Your data is now in the ScanShark Data Processing application.

At this point you can now generate reports and so on.
